For over 133 years, Madison Square Boys & Girls Club has provided a safe, stable, and supportive environment for youth in some of New York City's most under-resourced neighborhoods. Our Clubhouses provide our members the opportunity to build trusting relationships with adults and peers, receive academic guidance and emotional support, and most importantly, dream big.

The year 2017 was a momentous year for Madison, filled with growth and transition. As we gear up for the opening of our new Clubhouse in Harlem and the next chapter as an organization, it's important to reflect on what we've accomplished and how we will continue to optimize our programs to provide the best experience for the youth we serve every year. In the past year, we continued to see impressive success from our members. How successful were they, you ask?

During the 2016-2017 academic year:

- 96% of seniors in our Project Graduate Program graduated from high school and applied to institutions of higher education; 90% were accepted
- 86% of Explorers Academy (Ages 6-9) and 75% of Juniors Academy (Ages 10-12) members met or exceeded school attendance averages
- 440 members participated in community-based service activities
- Approximately 80,000 hot meals and 40,000 healthy snacks were served

Madison's expansion and impact would not be possible without the incredible support of our partners and friends. Your dedication continues to help us grow and make an impact in the communities we serve. We thank you, our Madison family, for being a part of our legacy of service. Because of you, we will be here to save and enhance the lives of New York City youth for years to come.







Sometimes life is challenging. Both of our parents are deaf, so Gabby and I have had to learn sign language to communicate with them. Our mom is

Puerto Rican and our dad is German, so we've had to learn Spanish and German too. It's not always easy, but the Club has always encouraged us and turned sign language into a passion. Gabby and I even talk about being interpreters when we grow up!

I've always been outgoing but Gabby wasn't always that way. When we first came to the Club, she was shy and I felt like I had to really look out for her. After 2 years at the Club, Gabby is confident and is often the most energetic girl in the room! I'm lucky I get to grow up at the Clubhouse with my sister. Madison Square Boys & Girls Club is helping us become the best versions of ourselves!"



Swimming is my favorite thing to do and ever since I joined the Club 3 years ago, it's been my favorite part of every day. The staff is always helping us become our best selves. We have the freedom to play sports and learn, which is helping me discover new opportunities, both in and out of the pool.

One of the most important things we've learned is about having a bal-

anced diet and that we should have 60 minutes of physical activity every day. We learn about healthy snacks and making sure our meals include protein, starch, dairy and vegetables. It's helped me rethink how I live and eat every day.

When I grow up, I know I want to do something related to physical activity; maybe even become a swim instructor! The Club has made me more confident. I'm even making more friends and doing better in school. Coming to the Club after-school is the best decision I've ever made!"

THE CAMPAIGN FOR OUR FUTURE

There are five words you will hear with pride: "I am a Club kid." Madison's Clubhouses are at the heart of what we do, and have been for over I33 years. They become second homes and communities where opportunities are abundant and expectations are high. We work hard to ensure that the thousands of New York City youth who walk through our doors are forever changed.

The Building Hope Campaign has launched Madison's next chapter, in which more of today and tomorrow's young people will know the joy of being a "Club kid." Through this \$90 million initiative, we are blazing a path forward into Harlem to build and open a new Club. Our four existing sites in Brooklyn and the Bronx—three of which have been in service for over fifty years, and one for nearly a century—will also benefit. The establishment of a long-term Capital Improvements Fund will support necessary renovations to preserve all sites at the utmost quality for our kids. Lastly, we are expanding our endowment to underpin this unprecedented growth.

In the fall of 2018, Madison will celebrate one of the Campaign's most anticipated milestones. We will open the doors of our fifth and largest Clubhouse on 155th Street and Bradhurst Avenue in one of New York City's most under-resourced neighborhoods. Over 400 youth will have daily access to our comprehensive after-school and summer programs and new community amenities. The Club will house modern educational spaces, a regulation basketball court, rooftop soccer field, teen center, digital art and technology lab, performing arts spaces, as well as Madison's administrative headquarters. We look forward to sharing this milestone with our partners, welcoming the Harlem community, and furthering our commitment to New York City's youth.






